SRA project takes off

PUNE'S largest development project being undertaken by Naiknavare.

Developers under the SRA Scheme at Ramtekadi is off to a flying start as the first building of the project has been completed in time and was handed over to the beneficiaries after the due completion of the required formalities.

In a special program held at the site S. No. 110, Ramtekadi, Hadapsar recently, 176 flats were handed over to the beneficiaries of the 'Prathama' building at the hands of Mahesh Pathak, municipal commissioner, PMC and the CEO of SRA, Pune and Pimpri — Chinchwad. Balasaheb Shivarkar, ex-state minister of PWD and Excise, PMC corporators Kavita Balasaheb Shivarkar and Satish Londhe, Dr Sanjay Kolte, additional CEO- SRA, Pune and Hemant Naiknavare, director, Naiknavare Developers Pvt. Ltd. were present on the occasion. Speaking on the occasion Mahesh Pathak said, "So far, over 3,500 homes have been created under the SRA Scheme and another 5,500 are being constructed in 25 different projects, whereas there is need of over two lakh homes." He appealed to beneficiaries not to give these homes to anyone else for any other purpose but to use it for their own stay and thus contribute towards keeping control over increasing slums.
